# **QUESTIONS FOR ADDENDUM #1**

# **QUESTION 1**

Please clarify the number of inches per call out and what the protocol is.

# ANSWER 1

DHS will be watching the weather if the forecast is predicting a snow/ice storm. In the event of a storm, DHS will issue a work order. If the storm happens unexpectedly, DHS' authorized representative will contact the vendor by phone and give a verbal approval, then follow-up with a Work Order the next workday. The vendor must not go to a site without an approved work order or verbal approval from the authorized DHS representative. The DHS authorized representative (s) will be given at the contract Initiation meeting.

The DHS representative, at his/her discretion, will issue a Work Order. The vendor will charge DHS for the initial call in accordance with the rates in the bid pages. If it is a continuous snowstorm, the vendor will charge DHS for each additional three (3) inches. Please refer to Bid Page 19A-R and Section 8 "Scope of Work" Subsection A1 to A4, B and Section 9 (pg. 103-104) in the Specifications.

# **QUESTION 2**

What is the current contractor's pricing?

# ANSWER 2

The contracts were solicited by boroughs as two (2) Small Purchases for one (1) year: 1) Manhattan, Queens and Bronx and, 2) Brooklyn. Please refer to Exhibit 2 for a copy of the current vendor's pricing information for both contracts. This contract is solicited as a large Competitive Sealed Bid for a three-year term, combining all boroughs.

## **QUESTION 3**

The bid documents require 10% bid bond and 100% performance bond, how is the vendor supposed to reciprocate that cost with no guaranteed call outs ?

## **ANSWER 3**

## There is no bid bond or performance bond required for this contract.

## **QUESTION 4**

Please provide the Prevailing Wage rate we should be using.

## **ANSWER 4**

There are no trade classifications in the NYC Comptroller Labor Law 220 Prevailing Wage Schedule for this contract. Therefore, mark-up to the Prevailing Wage Schedule does not constitute the contractor's bid price. Please refer to the revised bid page 19A-R in Exhibit 3.

# QUESTION 5

Is the PLA Agreement incorporated in the bid and does that mean you require union workers? If so what union?

# ANSWER 5

# This contract is not subject to Project Labor Agreement (PLA).

# QUESTION 6

Is there any minimum amount paid for a standby fee over the duration of the contract?

# ANSWER 6

# There is no guaranteed minimum payment for this contract.

# QUESTION 7

The Specifications say that sites are located within the five (5) boroughs but the bid pages only have four boroughs. Are there any sites in Staten Island?

# ANSWER 7

# No. There are no DHS sites listed for Staten Island at this time.

# **QUESTION 8**

Is it mandatory to subcontract a percentage to Minority-Owned and Women-Owned businesses?

# ANSWER 8

It is mandatory to subcontract the participation goals set forth in the solicitation. However, requests for waivers can be sent to <u>mwbe@dss.nyc.gov</u> and will be reviewed by the Agency and the Mayor's Office of Contracts for a final determination. If the waiver is denied, it is mandatory to complete the Schedule B upon submitting a bid or you will be determined to be "non-responsive." The Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (M/WBE) participation goal for this contract is 25%.

The Contractor will be alert regarding all snow/hail related weather conditions that affect the sites described below. **Beginning at 3" unless otherwise instructed DHS' One Work Order per site will be issued.** This Work Order will instruct the Contractor to remove all snow from all entrances, walkways, ramps, handicaps ramps, parking lots, loading docks and fuel delivery areas. The Contractor shall use the most effective means available (i.e., shovel snow blower, non-corrosive chemical product such as ice melt,) to remove snow, slush and ice. The contractor shall use all snow removal equipment according to the manufacture's recommendations. The Contractor before leaving the facility, shall inspect all areas to ensure that all entrances, sidewalks, walkways, ramps, handicaps ramps, parking lots, loading docks and fuel delivery areas clean and free from any snow or ice. The Contractor shall have its staff take before and after pictures with the site address, date, time and with a signed services ticket with their invoices.
